James A. Garfield National Historic Site Friday, June 9, 8:15am-2:30pm

Join us for a field trip to the home and presidential library of the 20th President of the United States in Mentor, Ohio. Garfield is most well known as a Major General during the Civil War, Ohio Congressman and skilled orator, surprise nominee for the presidential election of 1880, and one of four presidents assassinated while in office. The visit will include an on-bus discussion of Garfield's visits to Oberlin, an introductory film, guided tour, and time to explore the shop and grounds.



Rutherford B. Hayes Presidential Library & Museum Friday, July 14, 8:15am-2:45pm

For our second visit in our field trip series, we'll head to Fremont, Ohio, to learn about Rutherford B. Hayes, our 19th President. Most well known as a Civil War general and three-term governor of Ohio, Hayes was the "winner" of one of the most contested presidential elections in U.S. history, which led to significant changes in reconstruction policies. This field trip will include an on-bus discussion of Hayes' visits to Oberlin, a guided tour of the Hayes home, and time to explore the museum exhibits and grounds.
