The Friends of Westwood Cemetery and Oberlin Heritage Center are co-hosting a trip to historic Lake View Cemetery in Cleveland. This guided walking tour will include the James A. Garfield Monument, Wade Chapel, and stories of some of the historic people buried in the cemetery. Participants can meet at the Garfield Monument in the cemetery or sign up for carpool arrangements from Oberlin. The tour will begin at 10:00 a.m. and will be followed by a picnic in a nearby park. Pack your own lunch with your favorite goodies. The tour fee is \$5/person and space is limited, so you must register and pay in advance. If the trip is cancelled for weather, participants will have the option to sign up for a rescheduled tour or receive a refund. **Dress for the weather!**
