

Notes about Camps and Registration

Please note that due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the structure and logistics of these camps may need to be revisited and altered. Camps are designed to stimulate children's creativity and allow them to experience the history, architecture, art, crafts, and games of diverse cultures. An experienced educator leads each camp, assisted by student interns and occasional community volunteers.

Camps will be held on the OHC Museum Campus and are likely to include tours around town. Children must bring appropriate outdoor wear, a mask, a bag lunch, and a water bottle each day. Parents/guardians will be required to complete a health survey in order for children to participate during in-person activities.

Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations must be accompanied by payment. Children and grandchildren of Oberlin Heritage Center members may receive the member discount. No refunds will be made for cancellations within one week prior to the camp session (exceptions may be made for children exhibiting signs of illness). A camp session may be cancelled by OHC if a minimum enrollment is not met by one week prior to the start date and a full refund will be made at that time.

Scholarships are available to students who qualify for schools' free or reduced lunch programs (please inquire).
