## Ancient Cultures

*July 18-22 (Monday – Friday) from 9:30am-4:00pm*

Take a trip through time while learning about ancient cultures from around the world! Campers will discover people and places whose civilizations built the foundations for many societies around today. This camp will explore ancient peoples of the Roman Empire, Greece, India, the Americas, Africa, and Pacific Islanders through music, art, crafts, and games.



## Architecture Camp

*August 1-5 (Monday – Friday) from 9:30am-4:00pm*

Children will love learning the basics of architecture in this hands-on camp. Campers will tour Oberlin architecture, explore building materials, try construction challenges, sketch designs, create mini structures, and envision buildings of the future. Scouts attending this camp will also complete some requirements for Architecture badges.



## Kids through the Decades

*August 8-12 (Monday – Friday) from 9:30am-4:00pm*

What did children wear in the 1910s? What kinds of toys were around in the 1950s? How did my parents listen to music when they were my age? Children will get learn about what life was like for American kids throughout the decades of the 20th century, exploring topics such as school life, pop culture, chores, and recreation through activities, games, and objects in the Oberlin Heritage Center collection.

## Notes About Camps and Registration

Camps will be held at the **Oberlin Depot (240 S. Main St.)** and are likely to include tours around town. Children must bring appropriate outdoor wear, a mask (if required), a bag lunch, and a water bottle each day.

Please note that due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the structure and logistics of these camps may need to be revisited and altered. Families will be informed of current camp safety requirements in advance. Camps are designed to stimulate children's creativity and allow them to experience the history, architecture, art, crafts, and games of diverse cultures. An experienced educator leads each camp, assisted by student interns and occasional community volunteers.

Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations must be accompanied by payment. Children and grandchildren of Oberlin Heritage Center members also receive the member discount. No refunds will be made for cancellations within one week prior to the camp session (exceptions may be made for children exhibiting signs of illness). A camp session may be canceled by OHC if a minimum enrollment is not met by one week prior to the start date and a full refund will be made at that time.

**Scholarships are available to students who qualify for free or reduced school lunch programs. Please inquire.**
