Try making your own mini earthworks, learn to identify planetary movements and help map the stars as you create calendars, compasses, and

Notes About Camps and Registration

Camps will be held at the Oberlin Depot (240 S. Main St.) and are likely to include tours around town.

<u>Children must bring appropriate outdoor wear, a bag lunch, and a water bottle each day.</u>

Camps are designed to stimulate children's creativity and allow them to experience the history, architecture, art, crafts, and games of diverse cultures. An experienced educator leads each camp, assisted by student interns and occasional community volunteers.

Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations must be accompanied by payment. Children and grandchildren of Oberlin Heritage Center members also receive the member discount. No refunds will be made for cancellations within one week prior to the camp session (exceptions may be made for children exhibiting signs of illness). A camp session may be canceled by OHC if a minimum enrollment is not met by one week prior to the start date and a full refund will be made at that time.

Scholarships are available to students who qualify for free or reduced school lunch programs.
